approve Old 19 liquor license renewal. All members voted aye. All council departments will stay the same. Motion K. Jorgensen, 2nd A. Hintz to hire Jacob Johnson, Cory Dulansky and Karen Jorgensen for part time summer help. All members voted aye.
City wide clean-up is scheduled for June 1-June 15, 2024, more info to come.
