Resolution #14-02
Snow Removal and Street Sanding Policy

Whereas there is currently no street policy regarding snow removal and street sanding for the City of Hurley,

THEREFORE be it resolved by the Hurley City Council for Hurley, South Dakota, to set the following snow removal and street sanding policy as such:

SNOW REMOVAL

Once snow accumulation has stopped, the Street Commissioner(s) will determine when to start the snow removal from the City streets. The following is the general order of the removal (exception will be made depending on the day of the week, start time for school, or accumulation/driftng):

- o Main and Center (Fire Hall)
- o Center Avenue to Hwy 19
- o Monroe to Center Avenue
- o Park to Center Avenue
- o School
- o Washington Street
- o Residential side streets

The city will make every attempt to plow all streets as soon as possible. All snow is plowed to the curb.

Residents should not pile/blow snow onto the street. If snow is piled/blown to the street creating a hazard, the issue will be addressed at the next council meeting and action will be taken.


SANDING PROCEDURE

Upon the Street Commissioner(s) discretion, the following streets or areas will be sanded (in part/total) with city sanding equipment:

Center Avenue
School Area
Truck Routes

If deemed necessary, upon request churches will be sanded for funerals or service.


